

NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSING

Ontario Municipal Board Commission des affaires municipales de l'Ontario



The **Ministry of Transportation (MTO)** has applied to the **Ontario Municipal Board (OMB)** under subsection 37(2) of the *Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.50, as amended, for approval of road closings of various roads that intersect or run into King's Highway 407 Extension from Brock Road to Harmony Road, including a link (West Durham Link) which connects to the King's Highway 407 Extension approximately 0.5 kilometres east of Lake Ridge Road extending southwards to King's Highway 401, OMB File No. MM110029.

The above project is generally referred to as "Road Closures along the King's Highway 407 Extension", and more particularly shown on Road Closing Key Map of the King's Highway 407 Extension and the West Durham Link, from approximately Brock Road in the City of Pickering (Geographic Township of Pickering) through the Town of Whitby (Geographic Township of Whitby) to Harmony Road in the City of Oshawa (Geographic Township of East Whitby), Regional Municipality of Durham. The locations of the closures are shown on the key map and listed below. The plan reference numbers are: P-5054-0130 in the City of Pickering, P-5120-0229 and P-5120-0233 in the Town of Whitby, and P-5119-0059 in the City of Oshawa.

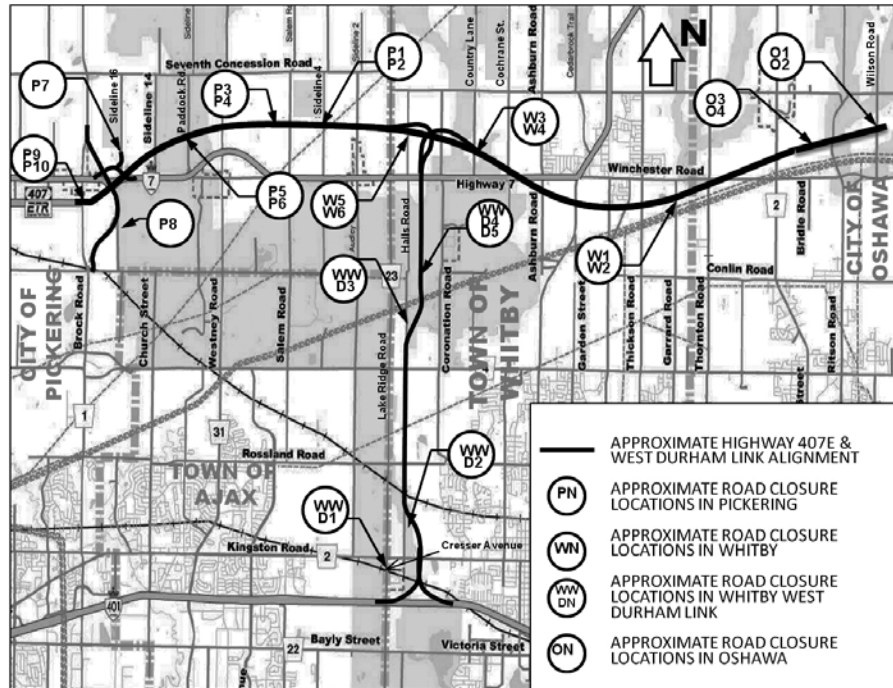

- Garrard Road (North and South of 407 Extension) in Whitby (**W1 and W2**)
- Halls Road (North and South of 407 Extension) in Whitby (**W5 and W6**)
- Country Lane (North and South of 407 Extension) in Whitby (**W3 and W4**)
- Cresser Avenue (in Almond Village) in Whitby (**WWD1**)

KING'S HIGHWAY 407 EXTENSION AND WEST DURHAM LINK

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The MTO project involves the King's Highway 407 Extension from Brock Road to Harmony Road. It also includes a link (West Durham Link), which connects to the King's Highway 407 Extension approximately 0.5 kilometres east of Lake Ridge Road extending southwards to King's Highway 401. The purpose of the project is to address long-term transportation needs in the area, improve the safety and operational service of the highway network, and also increase the traffic capacity of the transportation network in a manner that reasonably accommodates adjacent lands and minimizes environmental impacts. In this regard, the Ministry seeks approval for road closings that involve the portions of roads described in this notice at the point that such roads intersect or run into the King's Highway 407 Extension.

APPOINTMENT FOR HEARING

The OMB hereby appoints **Friday, November 25, 2011, at 10:30 a.m.** at the **Region of Durham Headquarters, Hearing Room 1B, 605 Rossland Road East, Whitby, Ontario L1N 6A3**, for the commencement of the hearing of this appeal. The Board has set aside **one (1)** day for this hearing.

All parties and participants should attend at the start of the hearing at the time and date indicated, irrespective of the number of days scheduled. Hearing dates are firm and adjournments will not be granted except in the most serious circumstances, and only in accordance with the Board's Rules on Adjournments.

If you do not attend and are not represented at this hearing, the Board may proceed in your absence and you will not be entitled to any further notice of the proceedings.

In the event the decision is reserved, persons taking part in the hearing and wishing a copy of the decision may request a copy from the presiding Board Member or in writing from the Board. Such decision will be mailed to you when available.
